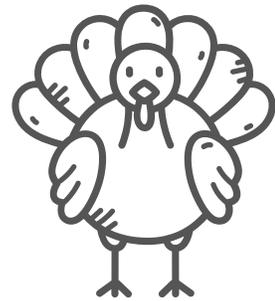


When did Thanksgiving Start?
