Answer Key

Open-Ended Answers (Sample Responses)

**1-Why was the Magic Lantern of Kindness glowing weakly?**

Because not enough acts of kindness were being done in the town, so the lantern's magic was fading.

**2-What was the friends' plan to help the lantern?**

They decided to do at least one kind act every day until Christmas Eve to bring back the lantern's light.

**3-Describe one act of kindness the friends did.**

They helped an elderly man carry groceries, invited a lonely student to lunch, shoveled snow, or baked cookies—any of these helped because kindness made the lantern glow brighter.

**4-Why was Lila giving her mittens meaningful?**

It was freezing outside, and she gave something she needed to help someone else feel warm—showing true compassion.

**5-What lesson did the friends learn?**

That the lantern's magic came from people's kindness and generosity, not from the lantern itself.
