All About Africa



Africa is the second-largest continent in the world and has 54 countries. It is surrounded by the Mediterranean Sea to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the west, the Indian Ocean to the east, and the Red Sea to the northeast. Africa has many different types of land, including the Sahara Desert, which is the largest hot desert in the world, wide grassy plains called savannahs where many wild animals live, dense rainforests full of tall trees and animals, and mountains and rivers like Mount Kilimanjaro and the Nile River. The food in Africa is very tasty and full of flavor. People use spices, vegetables, grains, and meat to make delicious meals. Some popular foods include Joll of rice, a spicy rice dish from West Africa; couscous, tiny steamed grains often eaten in North Africa; Ugali, a type of cornmeal eaten in East Africa; and tagine, a Moroccan dish cooked slowly with meat, vegetables, and spices. Many Africans also enjoy fresh fruits like mangoes, bananas, and pineapples.

Some examples are the dashiki, a colorful shirt worn in West Africa; kente cloth, a brightly patterned fabric from Ghana; kaftans, long flowing robes worn in North Africa; and beaded jewelry often worn to celebrate traditions.
